Implementing the requirements of ISO/IEC 17043 by PT/EQA Providers

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What challenges has the new standard presented to PT/EQA providers?

- Proving competence of subcontractors
 - Quality of PT items, raw materials
- Homogeneity
 - Costly, timing of results, nature of samples (volatility)



What requirements of the new standard have caused most problems for PT/EQA providers during the accreditation process?

- Justification of methods, statistics to assessors
- Validation of data software
- Determination of reference value (competence)
- Deputies for key personnel in small organization



What is the experience of PT/EQA providers with regards to technical assessors used in the accreditation against the new standard?

Positive – balanced knowledge

Negative – need to justify everything



How the PT/EQA providers ensure the competence of internal assessors?

- Quality Manager trained externally
 - Train internal staff
- Difficult right now because standard is so new
- Exchange assessors with another PT provider



Does the transition from ISO/IEC Guide 43 and ILAC G13 to ISO/IEC 17043 give increased confidence to PT/EQA participants?

- Difficult to answer invisible to participants
- Hope that new standard will be universally accepted (previous guides were accepted differently in different jurisdictions)



Has the publication of ISO/IEC 17043 driven more PT/EQA providers to seek accreditation?

- Too soon to say
- Increased need for resources may drive small PT providers away
- It would help if it was written into legislation (force PT providers to standardize)



Additional Questions

Q7 How do we handle notes in standard

Used for both PT providers and assessors to interpret standard for sector

Q8 Should we be more concerned about stability

- Different methods discussed e.g, sending samples to participants and having them returned
- Need to understand and accommodate in evaluation

Q9 Collusion

- Standard requires PT provider to have reasonable precautions to prevent this
- Send different samples to different participants

Q10 Reporting of results to authorities

 Does not breach confidentiality if participants informed prior to entering PT scheme
